SC Broadband is pleased to support education and has set aside funds to be used for educational scholarships. This scholarship fund is for the benefit of SC Broadband members and their families.

SC Broadband will award up to thirty-four (34) scholarships of \$1,500.00 each. These scholarships will be chosen by an SC Broadband Selection Committee.

Eligibility:

Each applicant must:

- Be a graduating high school senior.
- Be a dependent residing in an SC Broadband member household with active service.
- Have at least a 2.0 ("C") grade point average (GPA).

Terms:

1. Submission deadline is 5:00 PM on Friday, February 13th, 2026.
2. Applicant must be accepted by an accredited two- or four-year college or university, or a trade school.
3. Payments will be made directly to the registrar's or financial aid office in the name of the recipient upon submission of verified full-time registration at an approved school.
4. Scholarship may be deferred for religious mission or military service.
5. Scholarship will be awarded without regard to race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, gender, or disability.
6. The selection criteria are based on the following:
 - a. Educational achievement
 - b. Essay
 - c. Involvement in activities, honors, and awards
 - d. Career goals
 - e. Strength of recommendations
7. Scholarships are in the amount of \$1,500.00, awarded on a one-time basis and are not renewable. Termination of the student's school enrollment will result in cancellation of the award and any remaining funds will not be disbursed.

Application Instructions:

1. Complete the scholarship application in full using the official SC Broadband application form by Friday, February 13th, 2026, at 5:00 PM. If any information is incomplete, the application may be rejected.
2. Prepare a 300-word essay (12 point font, double spaced, one inch margins, and full name in the upper left corner with the title of your essay centered) on the following topic:
 - a. Tell us about yourself, your career ambitions, and an experience or experiences that have shaped who you are or guided you to the career path you have chosen. Additionally, if your goal is to return to rural Utah, please include that in your essay as well.
3. Submit an Educator Statement completed by a current high school teacher or guidance counselor.
4. Submit a letter of recommendation from a local community leader other than an educator (for example: elected official, local business leader, church leader, etc.).
5. Include your high school transcript with the most recent semester and all previous semesters. Transcript must be signed by authorized personnel but does not have to be sealed.
6. Application must be signed in pen where indicated.
7. All materials, including application, recommendation letter, educator statement, transcript, and essay, must be submitted electronically via email to scholarships@scbroadband.com and must be typed or scanned and submitted together as one document.
